



## 2010–2011 Oak Prairie Bulldog Softball Tryouts (Revised)

**NEW:** Due to the ASA National Tournament being one week later this year, Girls Softball tryouts for the 2010 - 2011 school year will be held **August 9th & 10th**. The tryouts will be at Oak Prairie Junior High.

**All 6th, 7th, and 8th Graders will tryout from 9:00 am - 10:30 am**

**All Pitchers and Catchers will have an additional tryout from 10:30 am - 11:00 am**

Girls who make the cuts will be expected to be present for both days. Games will start Wednesday of that week.

### Important Notes:

All girls trying out must have a physical on file at the school in order to participate in tryouts. This is a district policy - no exceptions. School physicals are now completed towards the end of school each year. This allows the physicals to be current for the following athletic season.

This flyer is handed out in the spring so that family vacations can be scheduled before these dates. If your child is not able to attend tryouts, they will not be able to tryout at a separate time. Also, please realize that if your child plans to miss a week during the season, she could miss up to 6 games. Either situation listed above would be unfair to the girls that will be able to commit to the entire season.

Parents, we appreciate the support you give to D92 and to your children. With that being said, the coaches ask that parents stay away from the dugout and refrain from yelling out onto the field during tryouts. These kids have enough pressure on them already with their peers and coaches watching them.

We try to pick the teams to the best of our ability. Please understand that it is not easy to choose from this many kids. Thank you for your patience and understanding.

There will be two teams again this year. Both the A and B teams will consist of about 12 girls.

We will schedule around 16 games for each team. A regional tournament will follow at the end of the season for the A Team.

Students participating in athletics, band and choir at Oak Prairie for the 2010-2011 school year will be charged \$20.00 for each activity, up to a maximum of \$60.00. The coaches, band director and choral director will be collecting these fees during the beginning of the band, choral and sport seasons. The purpose of the fee is to help offset the costs of transportation, officials, equipment and uniforms that are currently paid entirely out of District funds. Students who are unable to pay the fee will still be able to participate. District 92 continues to provide many wonderful opportunities outside of the classroom for our students. The additional revenue will help insure the continuation of these great programs.
