The Lockport Police Department would like to inform you of a service available to you that would aid in keeping you informed of existing emergencies or threat of potential danger. Will County 9-1-1 and Will County Emergency Management Agency, along with several Industries in Will County; have teamed up to provide an enhanced emergency alert system for your neighborhood.

The SmartMsg interoperability platform (Reverse 911) is used to notify the public that an emergency exists in your neighborhood (regardless if you are home) through email, pagers, cell phone text messages, or a voice message on your home phone.


The Emergency Alerting System is a supplemental warning system, backing up effective methods already in place such as sirens and Emergency Broadcast System/Emergency Alert System (EBS/EAS).

In the unlikely event of an emergency affecting your neighborhood, you may first hear sirens. In some cases, you won't hear a siren, but in either event you may receive a computerized telephone call or text message, page, or email from local emergency officials. The message will be about the emergency and what actions you should take (including shelter-in-place or evacuate).
